

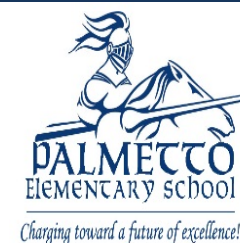

Stay in contact with your child's teacher. Sign and return all report cards.	Commit yourself to becoming an active and involved student in your education by: reading daily , practicing Math facts, participating in class, completing and turning in all assignments on time and being prepared for daily activities.
Partnership - Be Involved	Foster a positive and meaningful relationship between home and school. Invite parents into our school as volunteers.	Involve yourself in your child's education by talking to him/her about school every day, reviewing homework, participating in school activities and being a positive advocate for your child's school. Attend available workshops.	Interact with teachers and classmates in a positive manner. Discuss with teachers or any adult on campus any problems or concerns you may be experiencing.
Communication - Stay Informed	Promote a positive school relationship by increasing: Parent/Teacher conferences, emails or notes in the agenda, phone calls, signing your student's agenda and parent involvement activities.	Devote time to conference with your child's teacher. Sign agendas and homework. Maintain updated personal contact information at school (i.e. phone number and address).	Deliver all notices and information from school to an adult in your home.
Learning Environment	Provide effective classroom management and learning environment that is engaging, rigorous, and relevant to each child's needs. Build relationships between students, parents, and staff.	Promote a positive view of education for your child by encouraging and participating in fun learning activities at home.	Be engaged. Expect to be held accountable for Palmetto's expectations including CHAMPS and our school-wide expectations - Act responsibly, Be orderly, and Care for yourself and others.
